## Cruinniú na nÓg 2019 - Creative Ireland Funding for Creative Events for Children and Young People

### GUIDELINES

Clare County Council is seeking proposals for events for children and young people during Cruinniú na nÓg, the national day of creativity for children and young people on June 15th.

### WHAT IS CRUINNIÚ na nÓG?

Cruinniú na nÓg is a national day of celebrating and encouraging children and young people to take part in cultural and creative events around Ireland. The emphasis is on **Creative Participation** by children and young people.

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN CRUINNIÚ na nÓG?

With the emphasis on participation and trying new things we are now calling on artists of all disciplines (eg. craft workers, dancers, storytellers, theatre makers, street artists, musicians) etc. to make proposals for events that are aimed at children and young people.

We are also interested in hearing from heritage workers, re-enactors, coders and workers in science and technology and creative professionals in any artform.

Traditional skills practitioners or others with an expertise in landscape, flora & fauna/biodiversity, folklife, archaeological heritage, built heritage, history, vernacular architecture or any related field are also encouraged to consider how they might engage with Cruinniú na nÓg and its aim of doing, making, creating.

Any practitioner, venue, organisation or community group may make a proposal. If you don't have a venue, don't worry, just let us know and we will see if we can match you to a local community or venue. Likewise, if you have a venue available, let us know and we will see if we can place an artist or event with you. All events will be free to participants.

### HOW MUCH CAN WE APPLY FOR?

A total fund of €4,000 is available to cover the cost of selected events and event proposers should bear this in mind in terms of scale and cost. Funding allocated will go towards the payment of fees for artists and creative practitioners and materials required to participate. Proposals selected will reflect a variety of creative experiences and venues countywide.

Applicants are advised that the Arts Office reserves the right to keep proposals on file and to consider them for Culture Night 2019, which takes place on Friday, September 20th, 2019.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

The deadline for receipt of proposals is Friday, March 29th, 2019 and all successful applicants will be advised in early April.

Successful applicants will be required to provide a high quality image(s) / videos for use on social media and the Creative Ireland website.

Publicity materials will be supplied to all successful applicants.

Clare Arts Office will co-host the selected events on social media and invite each organiser venue to co-host with them

Proposals should include an outline of costs, CVs of people delivering the events along with a copy of your Child Protection Policy and any other information you consider relevant.
