

Issues arising from Site Visit on January 25th, 2016

General

The budget for the artwork is **€20,000 (including any and all civil works associated with same).**

There is no height restriction.

Due to the sloping terrain, the removal of the flower beds to enable access onto the site will necessitate the erection of some sort of barrier between the higher level where the artwork will be located and the lower level where the current memorial stands. This barrier may be in the form of a wall / panel / barrier / seat of some nature to provide support for those with mobility issues at the site and offers opportunities to be incorporated into the artwork.

It is proposed to provide low level fencing on the lower part of the site, surrounding the current memorial, for health and safety reasons. The area where the artwork is to be located (which is already elevated) will not be fenced and will remain open.

The materials under the sandstone flags currently on the site are not known, however it is suspected that they are loose materials as there has been a small bit of movement of the flags over a long period of time.

There is potential to reclaim the stone used from the removal of the current flower beds and to use it elsewhere on the site, if necessary.
