- Feasibility of the proposed project, budget, time frame, numbers etc
- Potential to leave creative impact on the organisation/group

Proposals will be assessed and competitively awarded by an independent panel. Do not assume the panel will be aware of your work.

Support documentation : Please ensure to include a current CV, website link and examples of previous arts and disability project work with your application. This is a criteria that will be assessed by the panel.
